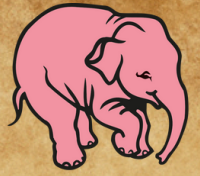




Delirium Tasting



DELIRIUM

Delirium Tremens 8.5% ABV



Delirium Tremens pours a brilliant golden blond with a slight haze and a thick, frothy white head that leaves a delicate lacing as it recedes. The aroma is lively and expressive, featuring fruity esters like green apple, pear, and a hint of banana, layered over soft malt sweetness. On the palate, it begins with a light sweetness from pale malts, followed by vibrant fruit flavours - apple, apricot, and citrus peel - balanced by a peppery spice and a gentle, earthy hop bitterness. The high carbonation lends a lively mouthfeel, enhancing the beer's crisp and slightly dry finish. Medium-bodied and effervescent, Delirium Tremens is both complex and dangerously drinkable. Its layered character and bright finish make it a standout Belgian Strong Blonde Ale, beloved for its bold yet balanced profile and its iconic pink elephant charm.

Delirium Nocturnum 8.5% ABV



Delirium Nocturnum pours a deep mahogany brown with ruby highlights and a thick, tan head that settles slowly, leaving a fine lacing on the glass. The aroma is rich and layered, offering notes of dark fruits like fig, raisin, and plum, alongside roasted malts, caramel, and a touch of chocolate. Belgian yeast character adds complexity, with hints of clove, nutmeg, and subtle banana. The flavour is full and warming, beginning with sweet, dark malt and fruit notes that unfold into deeper tones of toffee, molasses, and cocoa. Spicy yeast phenols and a delicate bitterness from earthy hops provide balance, while the 8.5% ABV contributes a gentle warmth without overwhelming the palate. The finish is smooth, slightly dry, and lingers with echoes of spice and dark sugar. Delirium Nocturnum is a bold yet elegant Belgian Strong Dark Ale. Its complexity makes it a perfect slow-sipper for cooler evenings, ideal for those who enjoy the darker, richer side of the Delirium range.

Delirium Red 8% ABV



Delirium Red pours a deep ruby red with a slight haze and a thick, pink-tinged head that leaves a delicate lacing on the glass. The aroma is intensely fruity, dominated by ripe cherries and dark berries, with hints of almond, vanilla, and a touch of tartness. Beneath the fruit-forward nose, subtle malt sweetness and Belgian yeast spice and depth. The flavour is bold and juicy, bursting with sweet and sour cherry notes balanced by a smooth caramel malt backbone. Hints of dark fruit, marzipan, and a light tartness enhance the complexity, while the 8% ABV provides a gentle warmth without overpowering the bright fruit character. A mild hop bitterness lingers in the background, leading to a smooth, slightly tangy finish. Its bold cherry flavour and smooth sweetness make it a standout Belgian Fruit Ale, perfect for those who enjoy a sweeter, more decadent beer with a lively, effervescent finish.

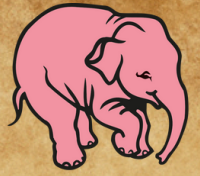
Delirium Argentum 7% ABV



Delirium Argentum pours a rich amber-orange hue with a dense, off-white head that lingers and leaves a delicate lacing on the glass. The aroma is a vibrant mix of citrusy and herbal hops layered over subtle malt sweetness. Notes of orange zest, pine, and grapefruit are complemented by hints of biscuit, caramel, and the classic Belgian yeast character, adding a touch of spice and fruit. On the palate, it strikes a bold balance between hop-forward bitterness and traditional Belgian complexity. Bright citrus and resinous hop flavours lead the way, supported by toasty malt, a touch of toffee, and gentle clove and pepper from the yeast. The bitterness is firm but not aggressive, and the 7% ABV is well-integrated, adding body and warmth without overpowering the hop and spice interplay. It's a unique Belgian take on an IPA, combining New World hop brightness with old-world yeast complexity—perfect for hop lovers who appreciate a twist of tradition.



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Delirium Black 11.5% ABV



Delirium Black pours an opaque, jet-black with deep ruby undertones and a thick, mocha-colored head that settles slowly, leaving a creamy lacing on the glass. The aroma is intense and inviting, with bold notes of roasted coffee, dark chocolate, and burnt caramel, layered over subtle hints of dried fruit, licorice, and warming spices. A touch of Belgian yeast peeks through with a whisper of clove and dark fruit esters. On the palate, it's rich and full-bodied, with deep roasted malt flavours leading the way—espresso, cocoa, and charred oak dominate, balanced by a smooth, dark caramel sweetness. As it warms, layers of fig, molasses, and a gentle, earthy hop bitterness emerge. The alcohol, at around 11.5% ABV, is present but beautifully integrated, adding a warming depth without harshness. It's a powerhouse Belgian Imperial Stout that combines the richness of a classic stout with the nuance and spice of Belgian brewing tradition—perfect for slow sipping and late-night indulgence.

Delirio 0.3% ABV



A lesser-known variant from the Delirium family and it carries the hallmarks of the Huyghe Brewery's bold, expressive Belgian style. The beer pours a pale golden colour with a slight haze and a dense, creamy white head that lingers nicely. On the nose, it offers a bouquet of fruity esters - most notably banana, pear, and light apple - alongside hints of clove and white pepper from the Belgian yeast. The flavour profile is bright and fruity upfront, with ripe banana, melon, and pear leading the way. These sweeter notes are balanced by gentle spiciness, including clove and coriander, and a mild alcohol warmth. A light bitterness and crisp, dry finish round things off, making it both complex and refreshing. This beer is a fantastic option for fans of Delirium Tremens who are looking for something just a little fruitier and more refined.
